

Chemistry Part-Time Faculty Pool University of San Francisco

The Department of Chemistry (<https://www.usfca.edu/>) is seeking part-time faculty to teach laboratories and lectures. Applications for this pool are accepted continuously, and candidates will be contacted when a position becomes available. Based on their length of service, part-time faculty can become eligible for benefits such as health insurance, retirement contributions, and tuition remission. For Spring and Summer 2024, compensation is \$2101 per unit.

Qualifications:

For lab instructors, PhDs and graduate students will be considered; teaching experience is not required. For lecturer positions, applicants with PhDs and teaching experience will be given preference; PhD candidates with teaching experience will be considered.

Job Responsibilities:

Duties for lab instructors include attending a weekly lab instructor meeting, delivering a short pre-lab lecture, supervising students during experiments, and grading assignments. Lab instructors also hold remote office hours.

Lecturers will be responsible for the entire class on their own. The course learning outcomes have been set by the Chemistry Department and these must be addressed in the course content. The lecturer has flexibility in how the content is delivered and how student learning is evaluated. The course textbook has been already selected, and prior syllabi and other resources are available for use.
